 BOND DAY of MAY A.D. 1862, at the Office of the State Treasurer TWO HUNDRED & FIFTY DOLLARS,
 which to remain to be received from Bonds anticipated on said Act to be derived from
 Government of the State of California with interest at the rate of SEVEN PER CENT per Annum,
 to be paid at the said Treasurer's Office on the surrender of the annual Coupons on the
 first of January A.D. 1853 and thereafter annually thereafter. This Bond transferable by us
 in part or in whole by the order of the Governor by his Attorney in fact.

dried in Our stitches...

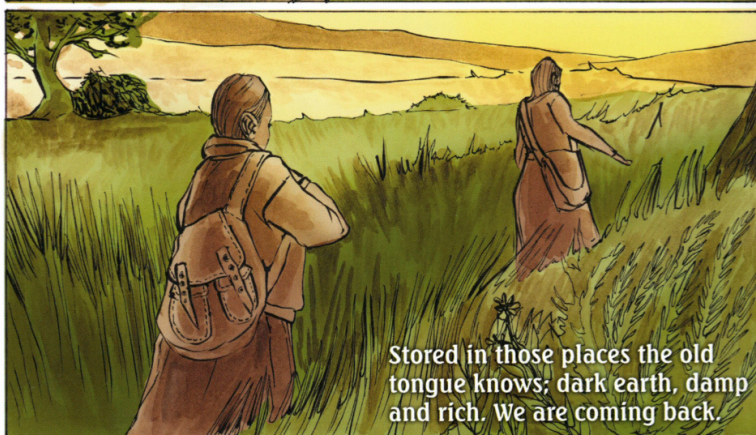


Yaangna:

dried and stored away.



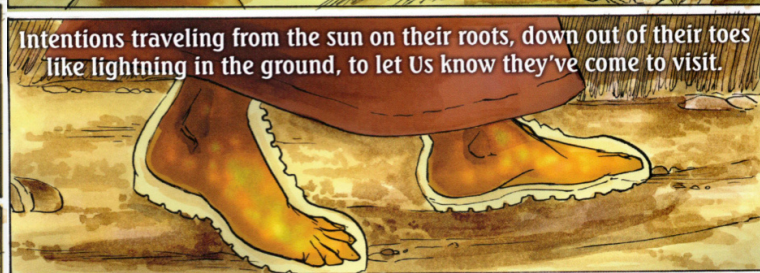
...We were buried deep for safe keeping
